



AJC Peachtree Road Race Start Wave Volunteer Instructions

- Start waves are designated by a start wave letter and number on the race bib.
- One exception is the seeded wave, which is just a number.
- If participants would like to run with someone assigned to a different start wave, they may do so by running together in the later wave. For example, if one runner is in Start Wave A and their friend or family member is in Start Wave L, they may run together in Start Wave L.
- Participants can move BACK in waves, but never UP in waves.
- Military bibs
 - The military bib is red, white and blue with stars and a start wave letter and number.
 - There is not one single military wave as they are spread throughout all start waves.
 - Pay close attention to the start wave letter on the military bibs, and guide those participants to the appropriate start wave.
